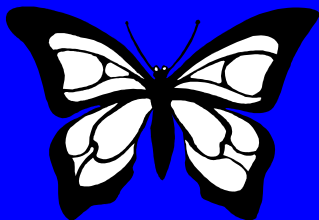

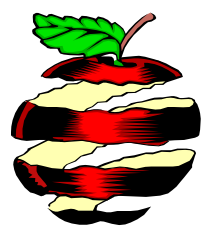

Petite little squirrels come out and play.

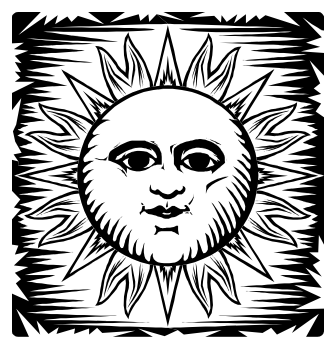
Really big bears awake from their slumbers
